

Panache Garden-Gazebo Ceremony

with Cake & Punch Reception

Garden-Gazebo (If Inclement Weather, Carriage House) Ceremony:

Time: Two hour period beginning at 10 or 11 a.m. on Saturday, or any hour on Sunday through Friday, with bride's arrival time beginning 30 minutes prior to start of the ceremony. If pre-wedding photographs are desired, bridal party may arrive one-hour prior to ceremony.

Planning:

Panache Meets with Bride (and others as chosen by her) for her to identify her dream wedding and review services offered by Panache ... as well as others that can be arranged by Panache ... to bring her dream wedding to fruition.

Ceremony Services:

Panache Officiates a Non-denominational Christian Ceremony, Coordinates the Wedding Party, Decorates Garden-Gazebo, Sets Up Guest's Chairs on both sides of Walk-Way (aisle); Provides Prelude, Processional and Recessional Music for the Ceremony and Establishes a Receiving Line for Receiving Guests. Panache will Map and Define Processional, Recessional and Ceremony Procedures which may include Meeting Half-Way, Lighting of Remembrance Candle in Spiritual Remembrance of a Deceased Loved One, Presentation of Long-Stem Red Roses (Bride Brings) to Both Mothers, and Inclusion of Family Unity in the Ceremony if the Bride and/or Groom have children. The Ceremony Will Close with a Reading of Legend of the Doves, followed by Release of Pair of White Doves. A Receiving Line of the Bride, Groom and their Immediate Family will be Established for the Family to Receive Guests Prior to Entering the Carriage House for their Cake and Punch Reception Activities.

Reception Services:

The Carriage House Will be Set up for the Event with White Linen, Accent Colors and Center Pieces of the Bride's Choosing. Panache Provides Wedding Cake as Shown on the Enhancement Page (white cake with butter cream or whipped cream frosting and gum-paste floral decorations in pink, lavender, or multi-pastel colors). One 10-inch cake will be freezer-wrapped to save for 1st Anniversary celebration. Activities Include: Cake Cutting, Official (Non-Alcoholic...Bride may bring Champagne) Toasting, Traditional Dances, Tossing of Bouquet & Garter, Newlywed Game, and Ending with a Party Dance Selected by the Bride.

Additional Attendees: Add \$10 per additional person. # Attendees _____ X \$10 = \$ _____

Confirmations: A fee of \$400 confirms the time and date. Half of the total is due 30 days prior to the wedding and the balance is due 10 days prior when modifications are made and all services for the Wedding Day are confirmed. **Confirmation fees acknowledge joint commitments to receive and provide services and are non-refundable.** Prices are subject to change without notice, unless confirmed.
